NETWRAP DIAGNOSTIC CHECK-LIST



Before calling Tama Assist - please use this check-list to diagnose any possible causes

Product

- · Is core protruding each end uniformly? YES NO
- · Is core wet/damp or deformed ? YES/NO
- · Is roll outer deformed in any way (bump on profile or missing threads) ? YES NO

Baler

- (?) Are both net tension springs fitted and correctly adjusted?
 - To ensure full and uniform net tension
- ? Is there loose netwrap on the outer roll surface (behind the brake bar) when roll is in net box ?
 - Ensure net is tight on roll to avoid slack continuing into the roll, which will not allow net to spread or cut cleanly
- Are feed rollers adjusted uniformly?
 - 1 To ensure net is carried to bale uniformly
- ? Are all metal surfaces that the net contacts with clean and free of dirt or rust?
 - **●**To avoid damage to net
- Is the net box clean and free of crop residue or dirt/stones?
 - To avoid damage to net and avoid net not being able to spread fully
- ? Are the bale chamber side walls shiny and free of paint or rust?
 - 1 To avoid net damage on bale from not ejecting immediately
- ? Is tailgate ramp damaged?
 - 1 To avoid net damage on bale when ejected
- ? Are belts, belt joiners or chamber rollers damaged?
 - 1 To avoid damage to net on bale surface
